

## HANDEL INSTITUTE RESEARCH AWARDS

Handel Institute Research Awards are intended to help individual scholars pursue a research project relating to George Frideric Handel or his associates or contemporaries. No single award will exceed £1,000, but more than one award may be made. Awards may not be used to pay university or college fees. There is no application form. Applicants should submit:

- an explanation of the research to be undertaken (what, when, where, how and why) and the intended output;
- an itemised statement of the expenses to be incurred;
- details of any other funding (for the same project) that has been applied for or received;
- two references (it is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that these arrive; the Handel Institute does not solicit references).

Applications must be submitted, before the expenditure is incurred, to Dr Helen Coffey (helen.coffey@open.ac.uk). Deadline: **30 November 2017**.
